The first part of doing the study is to take a survey of the parish, to receive the opinions of the faithful and determine their level of engagement in the master plan. *Please take the time to give us your opinions on this important matter by taking the survey.* Each family will receive a mailed copy of the survey sometime this week. It will also be possible to complete the survey online at [saintisidore.org](http://saintisidore.org) after the mailed survey arrives. The survey only need be done by paper or online, not both. *We would appreciate having 100% participation from faithful in the parish.*

A cross section of families will also be chosen to provide personal interviews privately with Cosgriff interviewers covering the same questions. The interviews will be conducted on-site during the week of November 26. The families selected will receive a letter in the mail and a follow-up phone call to arrange a day and time for their interview.

All responses to the survey and the interviews go directly to Cosgriff Company so that all your answers and opinions will be kept strictly confidential.

A final report will be issued to the parish and school, reporting results and conclusions along with an analysis and recommendations from Cosgriff.
