**Today is the Feast of Christ the King.** There will be a procession with the Blessed Sacrament after the 9 am Mass. We will also have Sung Vespers at 5pm this evening. Please come and join us.

**The Catholic Doctrine class** will be cancelled this week due to the All Saints Day party. We will resume next week.

**The Parish All Saints Party** will be this Tuesday at 6 pm hosted by A&R. There will be Saints Bingo, hot chocolate, popcorn, and prizes for the best costumes. Please plan on bringing your children dressed up as saints and with a short biography of their saint to present to Fr. McBride and the judges.

**All Saint's Day on Wednesday, November 1**, is a Holy Day of Obligation in the Denver archdiocese. A sung Mass at St. Isidore's will be offered at 9:00 am and a Low Mass will be said at 7:00 pm. Catholics in the USA are required to attend Mass on this day and abstain from unnecessary servile labor and commerce.

**The Usher and Rosary schedule** is in the vestibule for those serving.

**The Holy Name** will have a Requiem Mass on the evening of November 2, offered for all their deceased members. Afterwards, there will be a procession to the cemetery. All faithful are encouraged to attend.

**There will an Ascende Recollection** on Saturday, November 4, at 7 pm.

**Master Plan Fundraiser:** King Soopers grocery cards are available in the bookstore. Skip the line and come to the counter. Each card is \$100 (cash or check only). The parish purchases the cards at a 4% discount so as to make a profit.

**All Souls' Day envelopes** are in the vestibule for the names of the faithful departed you wish to remember during the month of November. Please put your envelope in the mail slot or in the collection basket. These envelopes will remain on the altar for the entire month.

### **Why do we pray for the poor souls in purgatory?**

Praying for the dead is amongst the oldest Traditions in Catholicism.

Indulgences are ways the Church has identified that we can "pay" God back for our sin and erase whatever "debt" remains outstanding. We can also apply them for the dead.

(CIC c. 994). CIC is Code of Canon Law of Latin Rite.

### **There are six General rules for obtaining a plenary indulgence**

1. State of grace at least when performing the indulgenced act;
2. Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;
3. Confession (20 days before or after the indulgenced act);
4. Communion (20 days before or after the indulgenced act);
5. Prayers for the Supreme Pontiff (20 days before or after the indulgenced act);
6. Indulgenced act: a special good work with special conditions of place and time.

There are two ways the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory:

- 1) From November 1 to 8:** visit of a cemetery with mental or vocal prayer for the poor souls.
- 2) On November 2:** visit of a church or an oratory with the recitation of one Our Father and one Creed.
