**Ember Days** are this Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. These are traditional days of fast and partial abstinence. Those who fast have one principal meal in the day, their other two meals do not together equal the main meal. Those who abstain partially have meat at one meal during the day while those who observe full abstinence do not take any meat during the day. Ember days are set aside at the beginning of each season to thank God for the blessings during the last and ask for protection during the next.

**The Parish Marian Mission:** Fr. Alphonsus, Maria, C.S.S.R. will be visiting St. Isidore's to give a Marian Mission. This mission will be held from October 5-7 and will end with enrollments in the Militia Immaculatae and a candlelight Rosary procession. The *Militia Immaculatae* was founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe in 1917. The goals as stated in the founding document are "to bring about the conversion of sinners, heretics, schismatics, etc., and especially of Freemasons; and the sanctification of all, under the patronage and through the mediation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Immaculate." A Knight of Our Lady's Militia is called to Marianize every aspect of his life through a total consecration of himself to Mary. This act of consecration signifies the transcendental, spiritual nature of the Militia Immaculatae which goes beyond a devotional practice. Please plan on attending the mission to renew and intensify your devotion to Our Lady.
