To observe the Ember Days, you take one principal meal in the day and then make sure that your other two meals do not together equal the main meal. On Wednesday and Saturday, you take meat at the main meal, while observing full abstinence on Friday. Ember days are set aside at the beginning of each season to thank God for the blessings during the last and ask for protection during the next.
