MEDITATION FOR SEPTUAGESIMA SUNDAY

"The time of Septuagesima is somewhat like a prelude to Lent, the traditional time for spiritual reform. The first step toward conversion always consists in humbly recognizing that we need to be converted. The lukewarm must become fervent, the fervent must reach perfection, the perfect must attain heroic virtue. Who can say that he does not need to attain heroic virtue and in sanctity? St. Paul urges us to undertake this ceaseless spiritual labor. To reach sanctity and heavenly glory we must never tire of running and striving, as those who run in the stadium struggle and exert themselves 'to receive a corruptible crown, but we an incorruptible one. I therefore, so run...not as one beating the air, but I chastise my body and bring it into subjection.' (1Cor 9,24-27-10,1-5) Only those who struggle and exert themselves will win the prize. Therefore let us also run in such a way as to obtain the reward." *Divine Intimacy, page 219-220.*
