Catholic Doctrine Class will not be held this week. It will resume next Tuesday.

Ash Wednesday: Ashes will be distributed before the 8 am Mass and after the 7 pm Mass, and after both Masses next Sunday, the First Sunday of Lent, March 9.

Fast and Abstinence: Ash Wednesday is a day of strict fast and abstinence for everyone from eighteen to sixty years of age.

Easter Duty: Every Catholic is required by the precepts of the Church to receive Holy Communion at least once during the Easter season which lasts from the First Sunday of Lent until Trinity Sunday.

Fridays in Lent: Under current Church law in the United States, all Catholics must abstain from meat on Fridays in Lent, under pain of sin. They must additionally fast on Good Friday. The faithful are also encouraged to fast each day in Lent (USCCB 1966, # 14) <https://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/liturgical-year-and-calendar/lent/us-bishops-pastoral-statement-on-penance-and-abstinence>.

Stations of the Cross are at 7 pm on Friday.

Third Order will meet next Saturday after the 8 am Mass.
