**Fridays in Lent:** Under current Church law in the United States, all Catholics must abstain from meat on Fridays in Lent, under pain of sin. They must additionally fast on Good Friday. The faithful are also encouraged to fast each day in Lent ( USCCB 1966, # 14) <https://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/liturgical-year-and-calendar/lent/us-bishops-pastoral-statement-on-penance-and-abstinence>.

**Easter Duty:** Every Catholic is required by the precepts of the Church to receive Holy Communion at least once during the Easter season which lasts from the First Sunday of Lent until Trinity Sunday.
