Easter Duty: Every Catholic is required by the precepts of the Church to receive Holy Communion at least once during the Easter season which lasts from the First Sunday of Lent until Trinity Sunday.

Fridays in Lent: Under current Church law in the United States, all Catholics must abstain from meat on Fridays in Lent, under pain of sin. They must additionally fast on Good Friday. The faithful are also encouraged to fast each day in Lent (USCCB 1966, # 14). <https://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/liturgical-year-and-calendar/lent/us-bishops-pastoral-statement-on-penance-and-abstinence>.

Stations of the Cross are at 7 pm on Friday.

The Ember Days for Lent are this Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. These are traditional days of fast and partial abstinence. To observe the Ember Days, you take one principal meal in the day and then make sure that your other two meals do not together equal the main meal. On Wednesday and Saturday, you take meat at the main meal, while observing full abstinence on Friday. Ember days are set aside at the beginning of each season to thank God for the blessings during the last and ask for protection during the next.

The Altar and Rosary will have **the annual St. Joseph's and St. Patrick's Table next Sunday**.
