The Feast of Christ the King is today. We will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament after the 9 am Mass.

The second collection today is for the building fund. These funds support the maintenance and upkeep of our church and school building. Thank you for your generosity!

Catholic Doctrine Class is on Tuesday at 7 pm. Fr. Robinson will speak on *Pope Pius XI's encyclical on marriage Casti Connubii*. It will be livestreamed for those unable to attend.

Benediction will be at 6 pm on Thursday, followed by the **All-Saints Day party at 6:30 pm**. Please plan on bringing your children dressed up as saints and with a short biography of their saint to present to Fr. Robinson and Fr. McBride. There will be treats and prizes for the best costumes.

All Saint's Day on Friday, November 1, is a Holy Day of Obligation in the Denver Archdiocese. A sung Mass at St. Isidore's will be offered at 9:00 am and a Low Mass will be said at 7:00 pm. Catholics in the USA are required to attend Mass on this day and abstain from unnecessary servile labor and commerce.

The Holy Name will have a Requiem Mass at 8 am on November 2, offered for all their deceased members. Afterwards, there will be a procession to the cemetery. All faithful are encouraged to attend.

All Souls' Day envelopes are in the vestibule for the names of the faithful departed you wish to remember during the month of November. Please put your envelope with donation in the mail slot or in the collection basket. These envelopes will remain on the altar for the entire month.

Why do we pray for the poor souls in purgatory?

Praying for the dead is amongst the oldest Traditions in Catholicism.

Indulgences are ways the Church has identified that we can "pay" God back for our sin and erase whatever "debt" remains outstanding. We can also apply them for the dead.

(CIC c. 994). CIC is Code of Canon Law of Latin Rite.

There are six General rules for obtaining a plenary indulgence

1. State of grace at least when performing the indulgenced act;
2. Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;
3. Confession (20 days before or after the indulgenced act);
4. Communion (20 days before or after the indulgenced act);
5. Prayers for the Supreme Pontiff (20 days before or after the indulgenced act);
6. Indulgenced act: a special good work with special conditions of place and time.

There are two ways the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory:

1) From November 1 to 8: Visit a cemetery while praying mentally or vocally for the poor souls.

2) On November 2: Visit a church or an oratory with the recitation of one Our Father and one Creed.
